A letter from the County Surveyor gave details of traffic diversion arrangements during the forthcoming road closure. Wide area signage would be put in place, together with temporary weight restrictions aimed at preventing use of local roads by large vehicles. Local diversion routes would not be signed to discourage their use by diverted trunk road traffic but temporary local signing for businesses would be permitted. Arrangements were being made for the re-routing of bus services.

RESOLVED that the Highways Agency be requested to place an 'Access Only' sign in Canada Road at the junction with the A36.
