FEES must be paid at the time of giving notice (cheques payable to Wellow Parish Council) (see current fees list)

HOURS OF BURIAL: 10.00am to 4.00pm

No funerals on Sundays or public holidays except in special cases sanctioned by the Council and in case of emergency by Order of the Coroner.
