Volunteers are reimbursed a mileage rate.

Full training is provided

Requirements:

- Good driving skills and your own car
- Enjoy working with people
- Good communication and listening skills

Drivers will be asked to complete

- A Criminal Record Check (DBS)
- An Occupational Health Form
- An on the road driving assessment in your own car (expenses for which are reimbursed).
