

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## Part 1 – Introduction

### The Neighbourhood Plan

Wellow Parish Council is preparing a Neighbourhood Plan for our Parish. The results of this survey will help to determine the underpinning principles and overall direction of our Plan, so it is very important that you make your views known and encourage your family and neighbours to do the same.

### What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

A Neighbourhood Plan is a means by which local people can influence planning and development in the area in which they live. Our Neighbourhood Plan for Wellow Parish will be for the next 15 years and it should:

- Create a shared vision for the future of Wellow Parish;
- Indicate where any new homes, sports facilities, recreation activities, shops and other businesses should be located;
- Influence how much housing might be built, where it might be located and of what type;
- Identify and protect important green spaces and other treasured attributes that enhance life in Wellow Parish.

### Developing the Neighbourhood Plan

Our Neighbourhood Plan will be developed in close liaison with Test Valley Borough Council (TVBC) and the New Forest National Park (NFNP) which is the local planning authority for that part of the Parish south of the A36 (Canada and Blackhill) although within the Borough. Once approved, the Neighbourhood Plan will form part of the local planning authorities' statutory development plans.

### Presumption of development

There has to be a presumption of some further development in the Parish over the next 15 years and therefore the questions in the Survey are based on this presumption. If you are opposed to any further development you may of course comment to this effect in your responses and this will be taken into consideration in the Neighbourhood Plan. Without a Neighbourhood Plan, the Parish could be more susceptible to inappropriate development.

### Housing and development

There is currently increasing pressure on local councils from central government to plan for ever greater housing numbers. There was significant house building in Wellow during the 1970's and 80's. This enabled many young families to move to Wellow and the child population increased considerably.

With limited housing expansion subsequently, the average age of the Wellow population has increased steadily, young people have left the village and cannot afford to return, The child population continues to reduce considerably. If this trend continues then it will be highly significant to the population of the Parish in terms of age profile in the next decade and beyond.

As we plan for the future we need to consider the impact on the Parish of this change. The results of this survey and other indicators may show that Wellow Parish has a need in the future for some additional housing for those already living here as well as those that might move in from outside.



### Footpaths and cycleways

A subject often discussed amongst Wellow residents is the lack of safe footpaths and cycleways connecting (1) the main built up parts of the Parish and (2) Wellow with Romsey. For example, routes that have been considered or proposed in the past are:

**Route A:** from East Wellow to School Road and onto Buttons Lane thus providing a traffic free route to Wellow School and West Wellow shops;

**Route B:** a stream side footpath from nearby the pedestrian controlled lights on the A36 to Romsey Road near Wellow School. This would provide a traffic free route to Wellow School from those coming from the Canada direction and also the centre of West Wellow;

**Route C:** traffic free or off-road route (e.g.separated from traffic by a kerb) from West Wellow to Romsey to provide a safe pedestrian and bicycle access to and from Romsey.

*(Note – the footpaths and cycleways described above are simply ideas that have been considered in the past. There is no guarantee that these can be either funded or delivered. At this point we would simply like to gauge the level of support for this for the Neighbourhood Plan.)*
